RESOLUTE SHUTS DOWN AUGUSTA NEWSPRINT MILL

Resolute Forest Products indefinitely idling its Augusta Newsprint plant. The plant was temporarily idled because of declining demand for newsprint paper. The closure will decrease newsprint by 214,000 tpy.

NORSKE SKOG TO CLOSE NEWSPRINT MILL IN AUSTRALIA

Norske Skog plans to sell its Australian newsprint mill Albury, addressing overcapacity issues in the newsprint market in Australasia. The closure is meant to reduce newsprint capacity by 265,000 tpy. Albury site could be converted to packaging paper production.

UPM FINALIZES THE CLOSURE OF PAPER MACHINE 2 AT RAUMA MILL IN FINLAND

UPM announced plans to permanently close paper machine 2 in Rauma, Finland, and the paper machine was permanently closed on 6th November.

Following the closure, SC paper production capacity will be reduced by 265,000 tonnes annually.

“The recent weeks have not been easy for us all. But in times of a continuously challenging market environment and an accentuated decline of demand for graphic papers, we have to secure the future competitiveness of UPM’s paper business and the remaining assets at the Rauma site,” said Anu Ahola, Senior Vice President, News & Retail, UPM Papers.

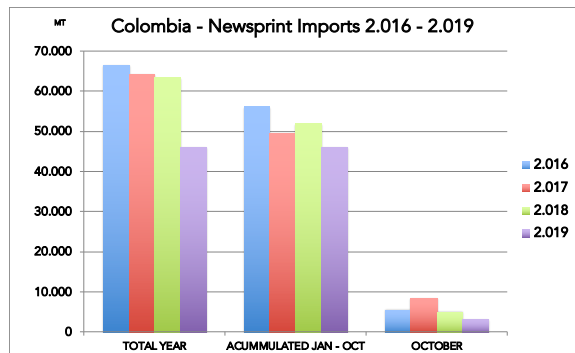
